Explanation of Responses:

- Represents shares withheld by the issuer to satisfy the tax withholding obligation associated with the settlement of restricted stock units ("RSUs") in respect of the issuer's Class A common stock ("Class A Common Stock") held by the reporting person.
- This amount includes (i) 249,102 unvested RSUs in respect of Class A Common Stock which are scheduled to vest on January 1, 2022, (ii) 28,728 unvested RSUs in respect of Class A Common Stock which are scheduled to vest in equal installments on each of March 17, 2022 and March 17, 2023, (iii) 86,184 unvested RSUs in respect of Class A Common Stock which are scheduled to vest on January 1, 2023, and (iv) 24,844 unvested RSUs in respect of Class A Common Stock which are scheduled to vest in equal installments on each of the first, second and third anniversaries of March 15, 2021, in each case subject to the reporting person's continued employment through the applicable vesting date.
- Represents shares of Class A Common Stock acquired in connection with the settlement of certain dividend equivalent rights (the "DERs"). The DERs were granted in connection with previously awarded RSUs, and settled in shares of Class A Common Stock in connection with the settlement of the RSUs to which they relate.
- This transaction was effected pursuant to a Rule 10b5-1 trading plan adopted by the reporting person on December 4, 2020.
- The price in Column 4 is a weighted average price. These shares were sold in multiple transactions at prices ranging from \$72.11 to \$73.10, inclusive.
